RMUoHP holds 20th Annual ENMG Symposium

On March 13th and 14th Rocky Mountain University of Health Professions (RMUoHP) sponsored the 20th annual Electroneuromyographic (ENMG) Symposium at the Marriott Hotel and Conference Center in Provo, Utah. Over 50 Physical Therapists and Electromyography specialists from across the country participated in the symposium which featured research presentations and lectures on pathology and testing of nerves and muscles to assist in the identification of diseases including carpal tunnel syndrome, spinal nerve problems, and other nerve disorders.

This year's keynote speaker was Dr. Jun Kimura, world renowned neurologist and author of Electrodiagnosis in Diseases of Nerve and Muscle: Principles and Practice. Dr. Kimura has made significant contributions to the field of clinical neurophysiology and his publications in peer-reviewed journals are numerous. He has maintained joint professor appointments between the University of Iowa and Kyoto University for several years. Dr. Kimura has served as the Editor-in-Chief of the Muscle & Nerve Journal, President of the International Federation of Clinical Neurophysiology, and President of the World Federation of Neurology.
