On March 13 and 14, Rocky Mountain University of Health Professions (RMUoHP) sponsored the 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Electroneuromyographic (ENMG) Symposium at the Marriott Hotel and Conference Center in Provo, Utah. Over 50 Physical Therapists and Electromyography specialists from across the country participated in the symposium which featured research presentations and lectures on pathology and testing of nerves and muscles to assist in the identification of diseases including carpal tunnel syndrome, spinal nerve problems and other nerve disorders.
