RMUoHP receives approval to continue in Candidacy process.

In January 2009, the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities voted to continue RMUoHP's candidacy status and approved the next site visit for initial accreditation. RMUoHP is officially on the Commission schedule for the next accreditation visit to occur in October of 2010. This initial accreditation visit will require a concerted effort by the University's Board of Trustees, administration, faculty, staff, students, and all other concerned parties. Candidacy is a five-year process. RMUoHP gained this status in November of 2005.
